This list was researched and updated by Dean Bones. Know that although he hopes this document is perfect he realizes there are probably many errors. Should you find some errors or have more information about anyone buried in the cemetery he would love your feedback. He soon hopes to have his contact information posted on SouthTillamookCounty.com in a way that is safe from spam bots.

I grew up in Beaver, Oregon. And as a young person in the lower grades of grade school I remember trying to help my dad, Raymond Bones, prepare to build fence on his farm property in Beaver that bordered Beaver Cemetery. When we were working on getting the border of the property ready for the upgraded fence that would contain a large flock of sheep I had no idea that there was a cemetery next to the property. We were removing old fencing when I wandered into a very heavily wooded area above the fence line and found headstones in amongst the trees. Some had fallen over. I can tell you that I was a bit freaked out and although the exact memories have faded I have no doubt that I got away from those headstones and didn't return.

In much later years I worked some with men from the Beaver Community Church a few times to maintain the cemetery that had been earlier cleaned up when the many younger trees were removed. At that time I wondered who many of the people were who were buried in the cemetery.

Fast forward to the early 2000s when Nestucca Valley Middle School staff and students that were housed in the building that formally was Beaver Grade School began and worked on the Heritage Project. During the years of the Heritage Project students and staff interviewed and met with many, many people who grew up in South Tillamook County to learn about local history. Students and staff also worked on quite a large variety of projects to learn about our South County history and to improve many areas including cemeteries in South County.

Other staff and students worked on mapping out Beaver Cemetery. And I became even more interested about just who those people where in that cemetery as I often didn't recognize the surnames. It has bothered me for years that all we know about many people buried in our local cemeteries are the dates they were born and died. The dash between those dates hides many stories about people's lives and their connections.

I finally took the time beginning several years ago to do research on the people buried in Beaver Cemetery. I found so many connections to others in our greater community and to the history of our community. And I also found so many stories. The last column in this Beaver Community Cemetery Record has bits and pieces of information gathered about the people who are buried there. I certainly feel a much stronger connection to them now that I have found what in reality are teeny details about their lives.

I hope to update many of the stories or those buried in Beaver Cemetery in the coming years.

Note that there are at least 39 unmarked graves in this cemetery!

Do NOT drive into the cemetery as there are many unmarked graves to the south of the roadway! Rows 3 - 6 have graves in the roadway.

Note that the lot sizes in Beaver Cemetery seem to vary greatly, so they don't always correspond from row to row. And some of the family burials appear to be inbetween rows or include several rows. Follow the line of a row to find the grave you are looking for.

Note also that the road up the hill is 1 lane and rather dangerous. There are a few homes above the cemetery and 1 below it. Watch out for cars coming toward you each way on the hill. You may have to back up or back down to allow the other vehicle to pass by you.
